Therefore, Voile launched its sub-category named “Jolaha” only to give tribute to these unsung artists and giving them hope to continue teaching their art in their generations.

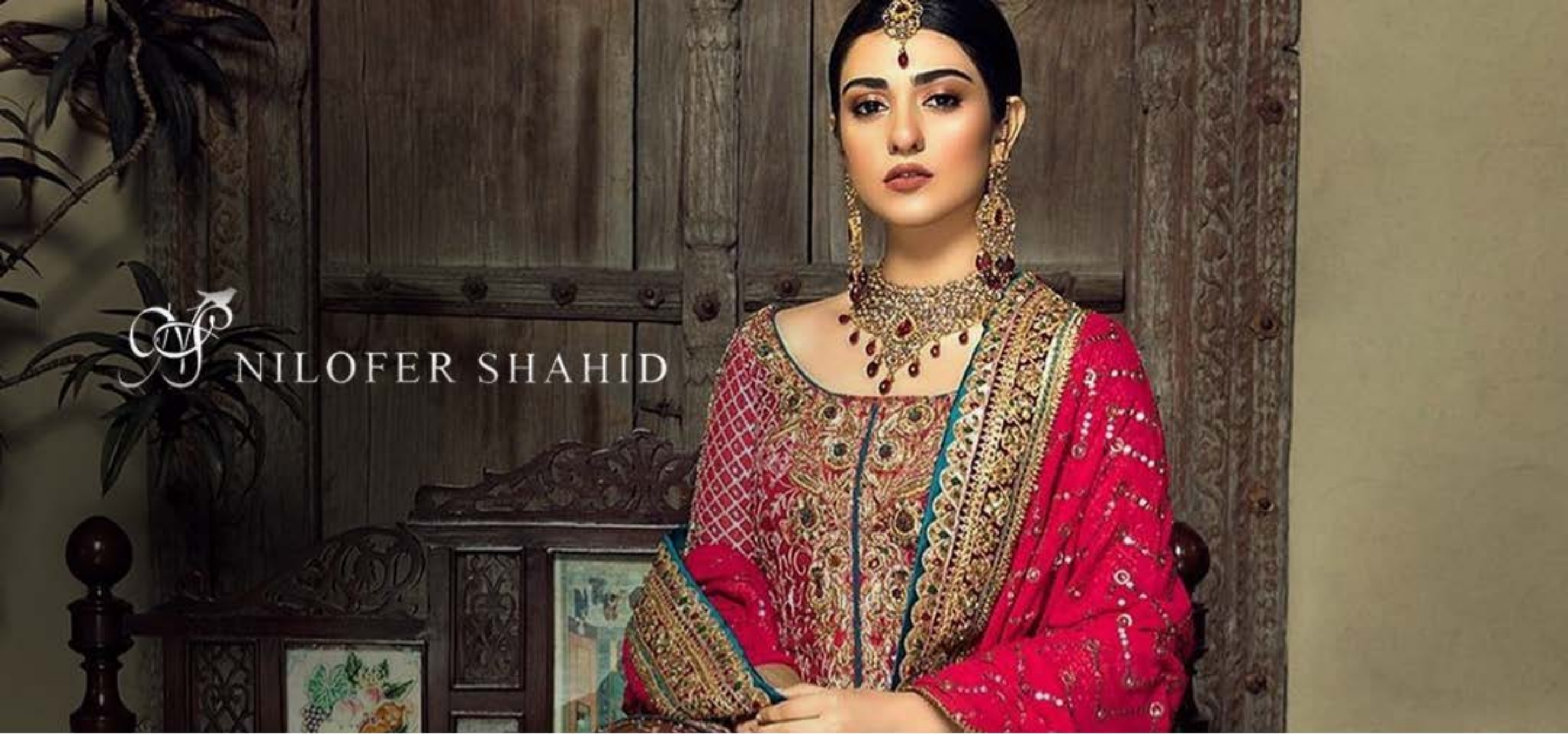
