


Australia is a traditional trading partner of Pakistan and the bilateral trade stood at USD 815 million in 2022, whereas the balance of trade remained tilted in favor of Australia as Pakistan imported worth USD 500 million of goods from Australia. In comparison Pakistan exported USD 315 million worth of goods, registering a trade deficit of around USD 185 million, and the trade deficit records an increase on year-on-year basis due to significant increase in imports bill.

Over the years Pakistan exports to the Australian market have remain stagnant though it has recorded an increase in the year 2022 from 2021. Whereas, on the import side there is a considerable volatility on year-on-year basis.
