

Srilanka is Pakistan's 17th export destination in the world and 3rd biggest market in
South Asia for Pakistani products. During 2022 goods exports by Pakistan to Sri
Lanka totaled \$ 368.6 Million against \$ 349.9 Millionn in 2021 an increase of 5 %
was recorded. While goods imported by Pakistan in the same period was \$ 74.3
million recorded an increase of 1 % as compared to \$ 73.9 Million in 2021.
Bilateral trade between Pakistan and Sri Lanka triggered after signing of Pakistan -
Sri Lanka Free Trade Agreement (PSLFTA) in 2005.
