

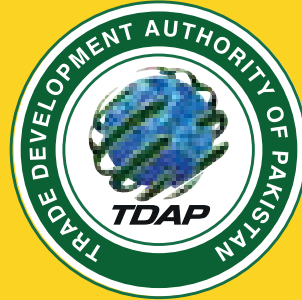

## Product Profile

Mango's scientific name is "Magnifera Indicia" and it is distributed in tropical and subtropical regions. It is usually 45-15 cm in length and 4-10 cm in width with shape of round, ovate and obovate. Its weight lies between 150 g to 750 g. There are different colors i.e. green, red, yellow, purple and combination of all these for 1000 verities of mangoes.

Mango is the second major fruit crop in Pakistan after citrus and Pakistan is the 5th largest Mango producer. Pakistani Mango is recognized as one of the best of its kind in the world market and Pakistan is the 8th largest exporter in the world. There are more than 200 Mango varieties cultivated in Pakistan, Sindhri and Chaunsa are the most famous mango varieties for export. Other commercial mango varieties are Langra, Anwar Ratul, Aman Dusehri, Fajri Kalan, Beganpali and Saroli.

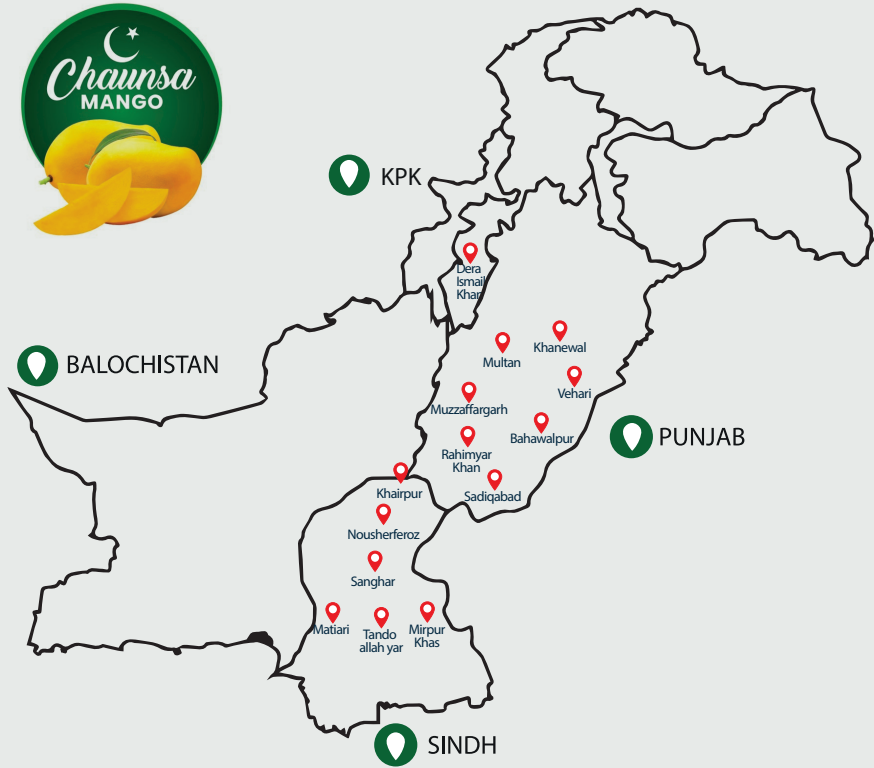

## Packaging & Storage

Cardboard boxes of 3Xply or 5Xply are used in export of Mangoes. Most frequently used box sizes are 5kg, 8kg, 10kg, and 12kg. Mangoes must be stored at 13C to 16C until they reach the destination market-shelf.
